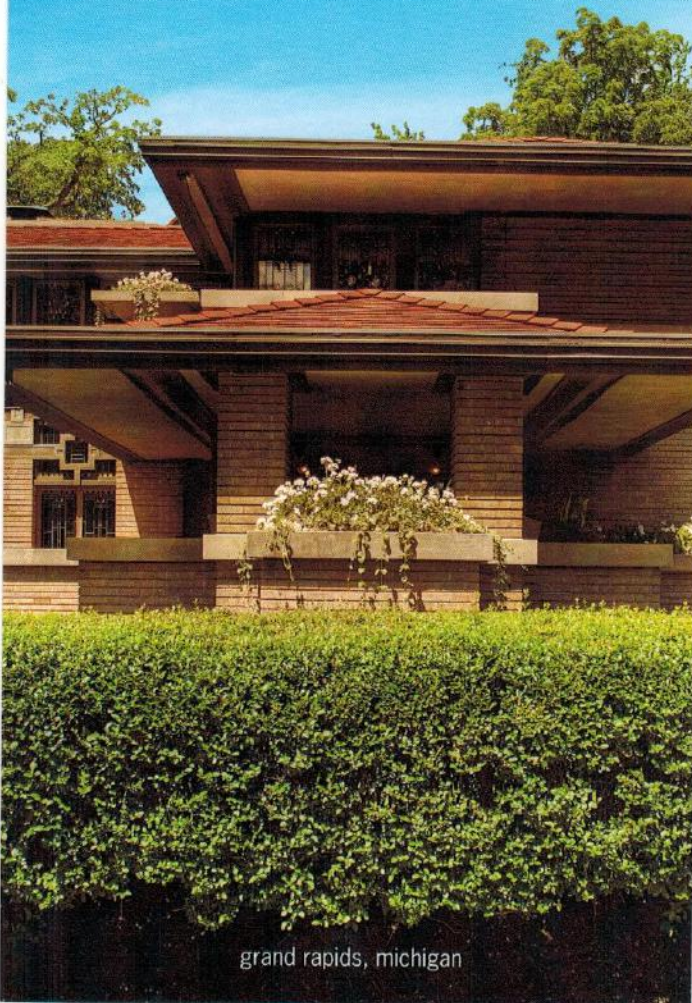


# FRANK LLOYD WRIGHT MEYER MAY HOUSE

**The Meyer May House, completed in 1909, is a mature example of Frank Lloyd Wright's Prairie style of architecture.**

Initially designed for a prominent Grand Rapids clothier, the Meyer May House was purchased and meticulously restored by Steelcase and opened to the public in 1987.

The Steelcase and Frank Lloyd Wright connection began in 1936 when Steelcase was contracted to manufacture Wright-designed furniture for the Johnson Wax Administration Building in Racine, Wisconsin.

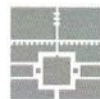
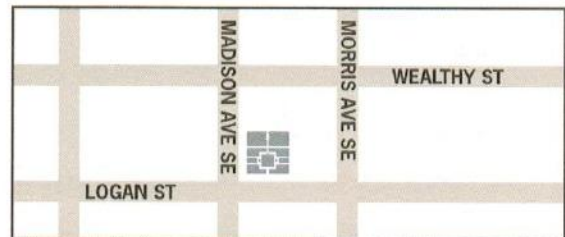
There is no charge to tour the house and view the film, *The Renewing of a Vision*. Please allow 90 minutes to enjoy the complete experience.
