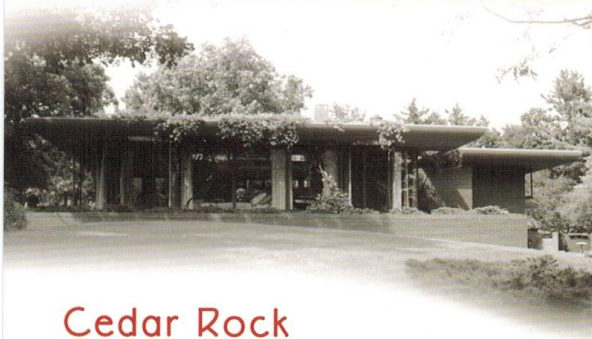


FRANK LLOYD WRIGHT'S CEDAR ROCK

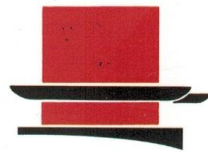


Cedar Rock The Walter Estate

Cedar Rock is an example of the simplified style of house Frank Lloyd Wright developed and titled "Usonian."

The estate includes the Wright designed boat pavilion and a barbeque pit which he called "The Council Fire."

Nearly everything at Cedar Rock bears the architect's imprint. Frank Lloyd Wright signed a small selection of his buildings that he considered special. Cedar Rock is the only Iowa structure he chose to honor with his signature.



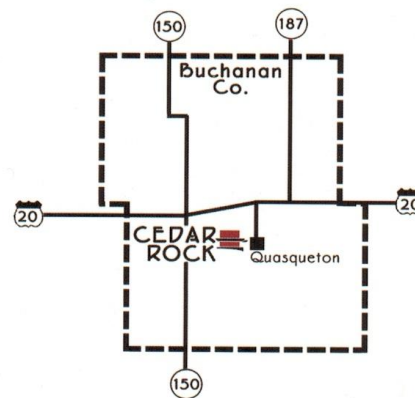
