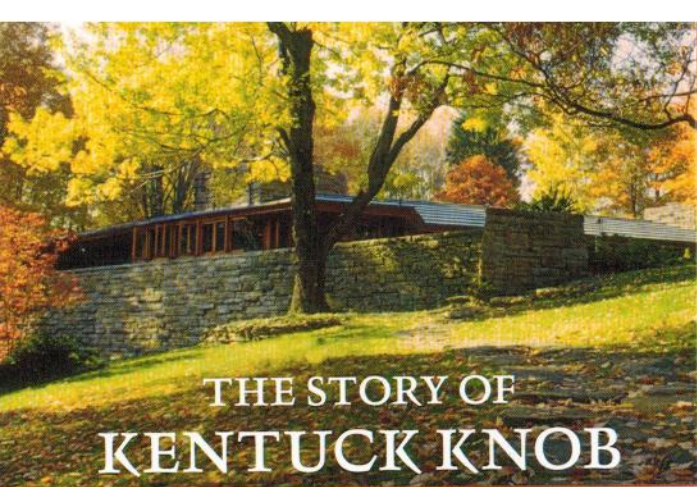

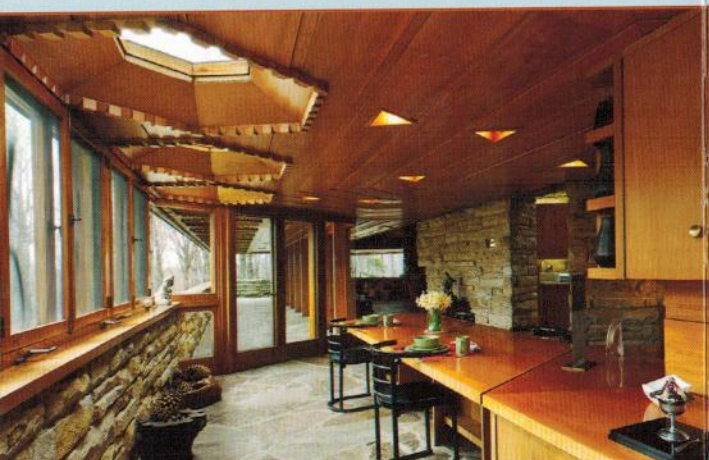


THE STORY OF KENTUCK KNOB

In 1953, I.N. and Bernardine Hagan purchased 89 acres in the mountains above Uniontown in Western Pennsylvania. After falling in love with Fallingwater, they commissioned Frank Lloyd Wright to design a house for them. This was one of the last homes to be completed by Wright.

Designed on a hexagonal module, Kentucky Knob is a small one-story Usonian house – a signature design of Wright. Both dramatic and serene, the house is situated just below the crest of a hill and appears almost part of the mountain itself. An open floor plan, cantilevered overhangs and great expanses of glass effortlessly integrate the inside with the outside.

Additional attractions for the visitor include sculptures by contemporary artists such as Claes Oldenburg, Ray Smith, Sir Anthony Caro, Andy Goldsworthy, and many others, that have been integrated into the landscape.



REGULAR HOUSE TOUR

Approx. 30 - 40 minutes. Available daily.

This tour takes guests through the interior and exterior of the home and provides an insight into one of Frank Lloyd Wright's most unique Usonian homes. Learn about the Hagans, Frank Lloyd Wright, and his vision for the home. After the tour, guests may explore the grounds and experience the magnificent view of the Youghiogheny River Gorge.

SPECIALTY TOURS

IN-DEPTH HOUSE TOUR

*Approx. 90 minutes. Group limited to 10.
Available daily.*

This is an extended tour of the house, including secondary spaces not available on the Regular House Tour, providing a deeper understanding of the building as well as highlighting some of the collections. After the tour, guests may explore the grounds and experience the magnificent view of the Youghiogheny River Gorge.

HOUSE AND SCULPTURE TOUR

*Approx. 90 minutes. Weather permitting.
Group limited to 10. Available daily except Wednesdays.*

This tour includes the In-Depth House Tour along with more detailed information on select artworks in the Sculpture Garden and on the grounds.

CURATOR'S TOUR

*Approx. 90 minutes. Group limited to 8.
Available on request.*

Led by Kentucky Knob's curator, the tour includes additional technical details on the conservation and preservation programs, as well as providing in-depth information about the house, including its history and architectural elements.

BRUNCH TOUR

*Approx. 2 hours. Group limited to 6.
Thursday thru Sunday, May 1 thru November 1.*

Brunch is served in Mrs. Hagan's Art Room providing guests the experience of dining in a Frank Lloyd Wright space. Guests are then taken on an in-depth house tour after which they may explore the grounds and experience the magnificent view of the Youghiogheny River Gorge.

SUNSET TOUR

*Approx. 90 minutes. Group limited to 6.
Thursday thru Sunday, May 1 thru October 1.*

This tour is similar to the Brunch Tour, however, after an in-depth tour of the house, hors d'oeuvres or a cheeseboard will be served in Mrs. Hagan's Art Room.
